Last year 12,919 women, children and men received services from South Dakota domestic violence shelters. Domestic violence affects people of every age, race, religion, social status, level of education and gender.

Inn it to End it, a project of Children's Inn, was created to promote a community wide effort to read the novel "Crazy Love" over the next few months. Then in October, during Domestic Violence Awareness Month, we invite you to attend one of six gatherings to discuss the book, it's topic of domestic abuse, and to tour Children's Inn. Two of these gatherings will be lead by a panel of community experts in the field of domestic violence.

The goal of the **Inn it to End it** project is to raise awareness of domestic violence and to discuss ways to help the women and children in our community break free from abuse and end this terrible affliction.
